Erik attended the CCLC meeting on May 17th, the commission will no longer be reviewing mall leases for outside dinning, and Community Development will take over the permit and approval process. Mitch Osur is working with the commission on a mission statement and to define roles and responsibilities. Over the past four weeks over 275 invoices have been sent out which represents 37% of the membership. Renewals and revenue are in line with projections, however there has been a slowdown on new members signing up. American Airlines will starts service to Los Angeles, Chicago and Dallas/ Fort Worth on June 2nd, with United Airlines kicking in gear June 8th with service to Houston, San Francisco, Chicago and Los Angeles.

The team is also working with our local partners on the wedding and meetings familiarization trip itineraries.
